



1 maintain an optional deferred compensation program for its employees and  
2 elected officials, and for employees and elected officials of any  
3 constitutional county officer electing to jointly participate in the County  
4 deferred compensation program.

5 (b) The Board shall authorize one or more underwriting entities that meet the  
6 requirements of law to offer approved deferred compensation plans under  
7 this section, and may change or revoke any prior authorization, by  
8 Resolution adopted at any regular or special meeting.

9 (c) The County Administrator is hereby designated as the Plan Administrator  
10 of all deferred compensation plans. The County Administrator, or his or her  
11 designee, may execute for the County individual participation agreements  
12 with each employee requesting the same and may execute such other  
13 agreements and contracts as are necessary to implement the program(s).  
14 It is implicitly understood that other than the incidental expenses of  
15 collecting and disbursing the employees' deferrals and other minor  
16 administrative matters, or as otherwise may be authorized by contract, there  
17 is to be no cost or contribution by the County to the program.

18 Section 2. Severability. If any subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of  
19 this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent  
20 jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision  
21 and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

22 Section 3. Codification. It is the intention of the Board, and it is hereby ordained  
23 that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of

1 Laws and Ordinances of Charlotte County, Florida ("Code"), and the sections of this  
2 Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention. In the event this Ordinance  
3 conflicts with any provisions of the Code, the provisions of this Ordinance shall control to  
4 the extent of any such conflict.

5 Section 4. Effective Date. A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the  
6 Department of State of the State of Florida within 10 days of enactment and shall take  
7 effect upon filing with said Department.
